### Professional placements:

- Guaranteed and supported by Cavalli College Team.
- Professional placements are essential to this NZQA approved qualification and provide real-world experience in a New Zealand centre.
- 18 hours per week in an ECE centre, plus two 20-day placements per year - no additional academic courses during placement, so learners can focus on hands-on learning.
- Learning Hubs and face-to-face tutorials support learners throughout their professional placements.
- Learners gain hands-on experience across a variety of ECE settings, age groups, and teaching approaches.
- Professional placements may be paid or unpaid.

### Entry requirements:

#### Academic:

- 18 years of age or older.
- Meet the requirements of the Children's Act 2014.
- Hold University Entrance or a recognised equivalent such as International Baccalaureate or Cambridge International **OR** International high school equivalency **OR** An equivalent overseas qualification as assessed by an international qualifications.
- Applicants aged 20 or over may apply under special admission if they do not meet the standard academic entry requirements.
- Meet the Teaching Council of Aotearoa NZ's criteria for determining good character and fitness to be a teacher.

#### English Language:

Evidence of meeting the Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand's English language proficiency requirements.

- IELTS (A) of 7.0 overall, with no band score lower than 7.0 **OR** PTE (A) of 69 overall, with a minimum L61, R62, W73, S79)

#### Other:

- Succeed in a personal interview, referee reports, police checks, and literacy and numeracy competency.

#### Documents required:

- Completed Application Form, Passport Copy, Academic Documents, Referee Report, English Proficiency Evidence, Police Clearance Certificate and Visa Copy.

#### NZ Teacher Registration:

- Graduates are eligible to apply for Provisional Certification with the Teaching Council of Aotearoa NZ.

#### Career opportunities:

- Build the skills to be an effective, practice-based teacher in early childhood settings.
- Step into roles such as registered ECE teacher, leadership roles, or other support roles across early learning services.
