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Professional placements:

Entry requirements:

Academic:

- 18 years and above.
- Completed NZ Certificate of Health & Wellbeing (Level 3) **OR** an equivalent overseas qualification as assessed **OR** significant experience.

English Language:

- IELTS (Academic or General) of 5.5 overall with 5.0 in each band **OR** PTE (A) of 42 overall with 36 in each band **OR** equivalent of meeting NZQA Rule 22 English language requirements.

Other:

- Succeed in a personal interview and police checks.

Documents required:

- Completed Application Form, Passport Copy, Academic Documents, English Proficiency Evidence and Visa Copy (if applicable).

Study Pathways:

- Diploma or Bachelor Degree options in Health Science, Nursing, Midwifery, Social Science etc.

Career opportunities:

- Boost earning potential and career progression.
- Find employment as a caregiver, healthcare assistant, support worker, or progress to senior roles.
