All applicants must:

- Hold University Entrance or a recognised equivalent such as International Baccalaureate OR Cambridge International OR International high school equivalency OR an equivalent overseas qualification as assessed.
- Applicants 20 years or older who don't meet entry requirements may be admitted if they can demonstrate the ability to complete the programme.
- Meet the requirements of the Children's Act 2014 and its subsequent amendments.
- For applicants with English as a second language, please provide evidence of meeting English language requirements according to Rule 22 of the NZQA Programme Approval and Accreditation Rules 2022 for a Level 7 programme.
